Welcome

Thank you for joining us on the Great Valley Center's (GVC) first-ever "Renewable Energy Bus Tour." The following document will detail our tour itinerary, planned speakers, and the menu for the trip. Action Items for You:

This two day bus tour will begin at the parking lot below the I-5 freeway at the corner of I St. and 2nd St. in Downtown Sacramento. Directions and a map are included in this guide on page 7.

Please meet us by 8am for coffee and treats. The bus will depart from the parking lot at 8:20am, so please be on time. Parking, as shown on the accompanying map, will be across the street in the garage from where we meet. The parking garage is patrolled and monitored 24 hours a day. Parking in this garage is included as part of the tour.

All meals are provided as part of the tour. The menu for the trip can be found within this guide on page 6. Please review it. You will be contacted regarding your choice of meals for both lunches and dinner by phone and e-mail this Friday and Monday. If you have any special dietary restrictions, please let us know and we will be sure to accommodate your needs.

The bus tour will involve a lot of sitting and walking, so please bring and wear comfortable clothing. Cameras are, of course, welcome - take as many pictures as you like. You may also want to bring something to take notes with, although a small note pad and pen will be provided.

Tour Ending:

The bus tour will end on Friday Oct. 8th at approximately 7pm. The final stop will be where the tour began at the parking garage at the corner of I St. and 2nd St. in Downtown Sacramento. Be sure to receive a parking voucher from GVC staff to pay for your parking prior to leaving the tour.

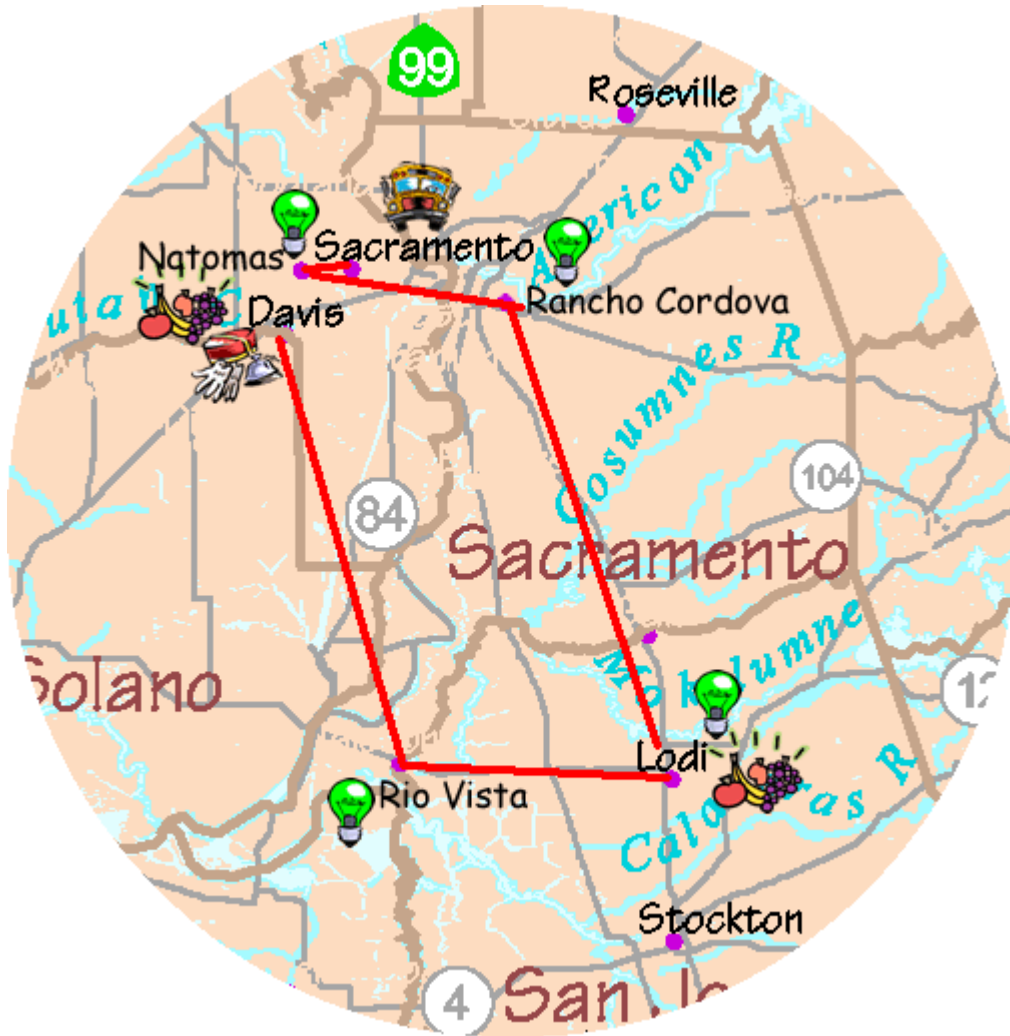

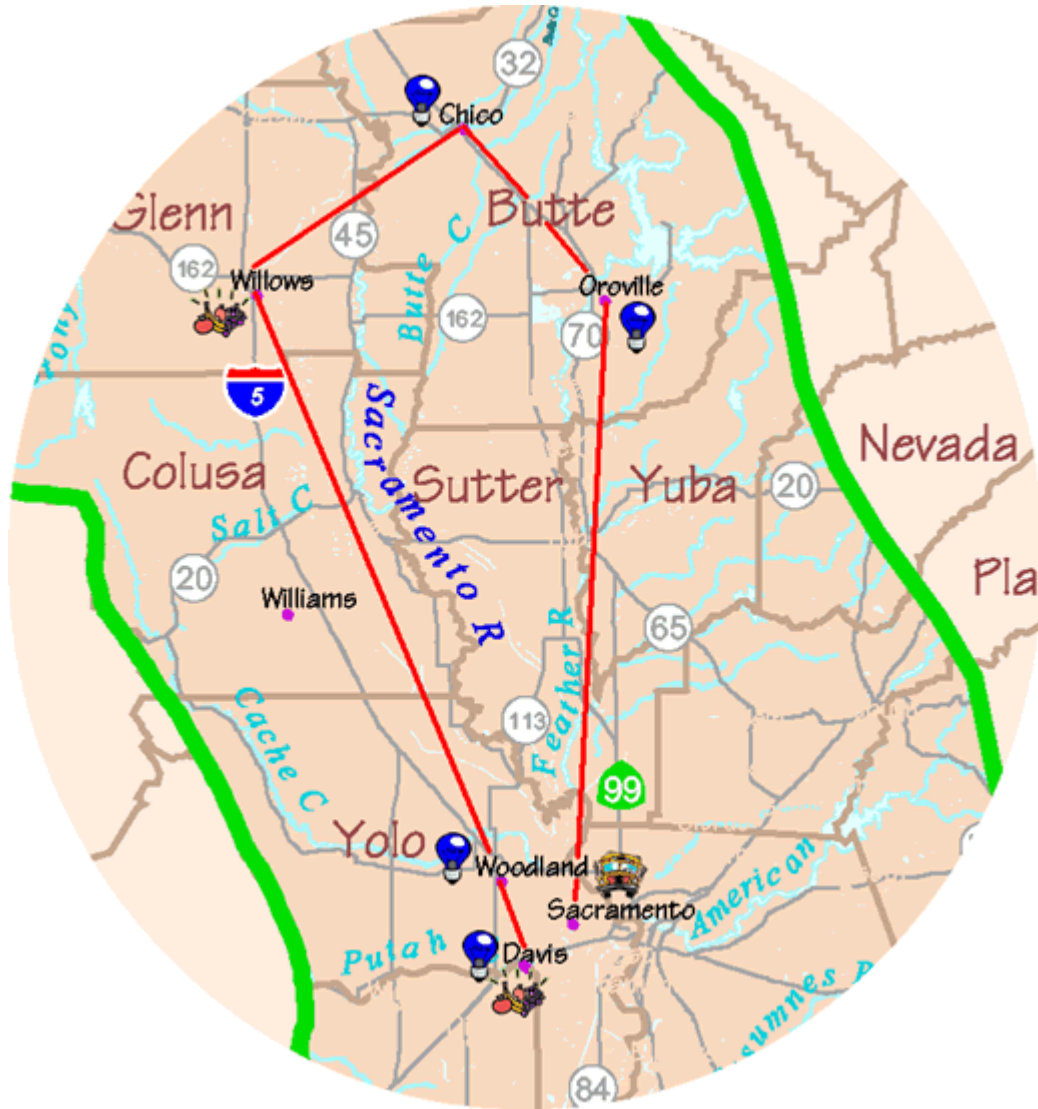

Directions to Bus Stop – Parking Lot W in Sacramento:

The tour departs from Lot W at “I” Street at 2nd Street in Downtown Sacramento at 8:00am on Thursday, October 7th. Park in the Old Sacramento Garage at “I” Street at 2nd Street (Cost of Parking included in tour.) You may park anywhere in the garage – remember to take note of which level you parked on.

I-5 North: Take J Street exit towards Downtown Sacramento. Continue on J Street in the left hand lane. Turn Left on 5th Street. Turn Left on “I” St. “I” St will turn into 2nd St. – stay in the left side lane when “I” St forks off to the left and right. After the fork you will see the parking garage on the right side. Take the stairs to Downtown Sacramento and you will be on 2nd St. Lot W will be on the right side at the end of the road of 2nd St at “I” St.

I-5 South: Take J Street exit towards Downtown Sacramento. Continue on J Street in the left hand lane. Turn Left on 5th Street. Turn Left on “I” St. “I” St will turn into 2nd St. – stay in the left side lane when “I” St forks off to the left and right. After the fork you will see the parking garage on the right side. Take the stairs to Downtown Sacramento and you will be on 2nd St. Lot W will be on the right side at the end of the road of 2nd St at “I” St.
